A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF PLUMAS PROVIDING AUTHORITY FOR THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO DELAY OR REVERSE ANY ACTION BY AN APPOINTED DEPARTMENT HEAD UNTIL THE NEXT BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' MEETING

WHEREAS, there is a need for greater review of actions that may result in liability to the County; and,


WHEREAS, the County Administrative Officer (CAO) serves at the pleasure of the Board and is the chief administrator of the County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board desires the CAO to have the authority to temporarily hold items that he believes should be reviewed by the Board,


NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Plumas hereby grants the authority for the CAO to delay or reverse any action by an appointed department head until the matter may be brought before the BOS when such action (a) involves personnel matters, including hiring, discipline or termination (b) may cause potential liability to the County, (c) encumbers funds that are not budgeted; or (d) presents any other issue, which the CAO deems in his discretion, should be determined by the BOS. In the matter of personnel actions, the Department Head still may place the employee on administrative leave until the matter is resolved.
