Emergency Shelter to Open for Displaced Dixie and Beckwourth Fire Evacuees

On Monday, October 18th, a Fire victim shelter will be opened **at Greenville Elementary School (225 Grand Street)**. With the incoming inclement weather next week, it is critical fire survivors without shelter be provided a place out of the rain, wind and winter elements.

This shelter will be operated by the county's Department of Social Services. Meals will be provided. This shelter will be open to those who lost their residence as a result of the Dixie and Beckwourth Fires.

The county, along with our State and Federal partners, will assist fire victims in making sure they have signed up for all available services including non-profit and FEMA assistance, to ensure they receive assistance in planning long-term housing solutions.

The shelter will open at 2:00 PM on Monday (10/18). COVID-19 continues to pose a serious public health risk. Precautions will be taken to ensure the health and safety of all attendees. Please wear a mask and continue to practice social distancing. If you think you have been exposed or are experiencing any symptoms, please notify the nursing staff immediately upon arrival.
