Plumas County Board of Supervisors to Adopt Final Map on December 7, 2021 at the 10:00 Board Meeting

Quincy, Calif. (December 3, 2021) – On December 7, 2021, following the four public hearings, the Plumas County Board of Supervisors will approve an Ordinance adopting the Final Map that will change the supervisorial districts for the next 10 years. The meeting will be held in the Board of Supervisors' Chambers, located at 520 Main Street, Room 308, Quincy, CA, 95971. The meeting will also be available to attend virtually via zoom.

On November 23, 2021, the Board discussed changes to the final draft maps presented, and verbally instructed staff as to additional changes. On November 30th the County posted their final three maps, available to be reviewed at:
