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**APPLICATION FOR CANCELLATION OF PENALTIES
IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 4985.2 OF THE
CALIFORNIA REVENUE AND TAXATION CODE**

In accordance with law, the tax collector may, under certain conditions, cancel penalties on delinquent taxes when failure to make a timely payment is due to reasonable cause and circumstances beyond the taxpayer's control, and occurred notwithstanding the exercise of ordinary care in the absence of willful neglect. The conditions include: application accompanied by check to pay taxes indicated in full and taxpayer's ability to demonstrate reasonable cause and circumstances beyond the taxpayer's control.

In order for the tax collector to consider cancellation of your penalties, it is necessary for you to provide the information requested below and to sign, under penalty of perjury, that the information you are providing is true and correct to the best of your knowledge.
