On Saturday night, February 26, 2022 at approximately 11:12 PM the Plumas County Dispatch Center received a report of a vandalism which had occurred to a mural located at the intersection of Main Street and Bradley Street in Quincy. A Sergeant and Deputy responded to the area. After checking the area, the Sergeant and Deputy located a female subject who had paint on her person and clothing matching the paint on the mural. An investigation was conducted leading to the arrest of the female subject for unrelated charges. A charge of vandalism will be referred to the Plumas County District Attorney's Office to review for prosecution.
