What color will PG&E be using to mark Tree Markings in fire footprint?

- PG&E will using green paint for trees to be removed

Will PG&E remove cut vegetation on private property and county right of way?

- We will remove trees cut on private property at the landowners request. Landowners need to contact us at wildfiresafety@pge.com or 1-877-295-4949 to request a permission form that we need to enter their property
- We'll also remove cut trees from County right of way. Where County only has an easement we'll also work with the property owner for permission.

How will cut trees will be removed?

- At this point we only plan to haul cut trees by truck. We're still working to identify where trees will be hauled to. Where possible we will chip and haul to biomass facilities.
