Update on Recovery Status

- A number of recently approved Canyon Dam commercial sites have been cleared of debris including Quail Lodge.
- The main road through Warner Valley has been plowed by Nation Park Service. The County will plow side street as soon as possible.
- Debris Removal has started in both Warner Valley and Frenchman Lake. There is 1 Crew working strictly in Warner Valley and another moving between Warner Valley, Chester, and East Tehama.
- Hazardous tree removal operations have re-started in Warner Valley – 1 Crew performing tree operations this week with possibility of another crew assisting soon. Crews are coordinating safe operations and minimize congestion with multiple debris and tree crews in the area.
- 2 Crews working in the Dixie/Frenchman area and 1 Crew working in the Last Chance area, near Frenchmen Lake.
- PGE's mobile help center will be out at Greenville High School on April 7 from 9:00am-1:00pm . Staff will answer questions and provide information on reestablishing electric service for rebuilt homes and businesses, as well as ask questions about tree removals.
