Rising COVID-19 Case Numbers

Between seasonal allergies and fatigue from the already busy summer schedules, it can be difficult to realize when it might be time to test for COVID-19. Recently, Plumas County Public Health Agency has seen a sustained increase in reported COVID-19 cases. During the month of May, 138 positive COVID-19 cases were reported in comparison to 26 and 27 cases in April and March 2022, respectively. The actual number of COVID-19 cases is estimated to be higher than these reported numbers due to the availability and convenience of home testing, which often are not reported. This increase in cases is driven by new variants of the coronavirus.

California Department of Public Health (CDPH) still strongly recommends wearing a well-fitting mask anytime indoors or in a crowded area such as public transport and indoor events. Staying up to date on COVID-19 vaccines and boosters still remains the strongest way to prevent infection, serious disease, hospitalization or death. If someone has been exposed to or has symptoms of COVID-19, they should test at home or at the hospital. If someone tests positive, follow CDPH's current guidance for isolation. Guidance for both exposed individuals and those that test positive for COVID-19 can be found [here](#). If they are over 60 years old or have other medical conditions, they should discuss with their medical provider about available treatments. Treatments require a prescription and are available at pharmacies and hospitals within Plumas County.
