OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

1. Be sure to keep cold foods at or below 41°F and under refrigeration whenever possible. Found MS prepared sandwiches, 2 boxes of frozen burritos, 2 boxes of Jimmy Dean Bagel sandwiches in prep area on counters. Staff explained they were unboxing and would be in refrig or freezer for customer sales. Recommend handling smaller portions to avoid having potentially hazardous foods ~~at~~ out of refrigeration.
- * 1. Provide a certified food safety manager as soon as possible. Temporary permit for food prep expired 8/19/2022.
4. Use a container with sanitizer for wiping rags. Found cloth rags on counter & on dish sink, without sanitizer these rags can spread contamination.
