OBSERVATIONS AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

Good food safety knowledge and practices observed throughout facility. All temperatures of potentially hazardous foods were found to be within accepted ranges of less than 41°F or greater than 135°F.

Only recommendation for display of frozen USDA meats re-packaged and frozen for retail sales is to add a date to the label. This will help ensure frozen foods are sold first-in, first-out and don't exceed holding times.
