Potential Projects



Microgrids

Description: To avoid and reduce health, safety, and economic impacts caused by power outages, develop power microgrids to provide for a more resilient, reliable, and sustainable energy supply. Microgrids continue to provide electricity to a covered area during power outages, benefitting public health, safety, and the economy.



Broadband Improvements

Description: To restore reliable high-speed internet and expand system to support community needs, especially to unserved and underserved areas, with an initial focus on telemedicine and economic development.



Greenville Cemetery District Irrigation System & Secondary Fire Flow Protection for Greenville

Description: Reconstruct the fire-damaged overland pipe system that feeds irrigation water from the Round Valley Reservoir to the Greenville Cemetery District. Also, research possibility of irrigation line doubling as a secondary fire flow line to connect to the Greenville fire hydrant system as a backup during electrical outages.



Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations

Description: To spur economic opportunities and support the transition to electric vehicles, develop a plan which outlines a path forward to transition public transit fleets to EV. It will also identify specific EV needs along with required charging infrastructure and opportunities to share charging facilities between public agencies.



Indian Valley Community Services District Water and Sewer Projects

Description: Restore water and sewer infrastructure for Greenville and Indian Valley customers and assess future sanitation and potable and non-potable water needs.



Greenville Pavement Repairs

Description: The project will re-establish the existing pavement width and condition to allow for two-way traffic, on-street parking, drainage, and snow removal in Greenville including the repair of fire-damaged pavements and addition of new curb ramps.



Assistance for Owners Addressing Property Boundaries

Description: Identify long-term strategies to assist property owners with boundary line conflicts and issues including possible cost burden reductions through joint neighborhood survey projects.
