

ECON RSF — Economic Development Long-Term Recovery Plan Working Group

Lead: Plumas County (Supported by Cal OES, FEMA, and DFC)

- 1 of 5 recovery functions for long-term recovery planning
- 5+ year timeframe for recovery and resiliency projects
- Long-Term Recovery Plan to be adopted in August 2023

CEDS — Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (5-year)

Lead: Sierra Business Council

- Funded by EDA
- Requires joining Sierra Economic Development District
- Multi-county strategy to diversify and grow regional economies
- Plan to be completed by end of 2023

An equitable, diversified, and sustainable economy that supports living wage jobs.

RERC — Recreation Economy for Rural Communities Quincy Action Plan

Lead: Sierra Buttes Trail Stewardship

- Funded by EPA and USFS
- Recreation as driver of economic growth
- Focus of revitalizing downtown Quincy business district
- Identified several 1-2 year action strategies
- Published in November 2022

CERF — Community Economic Resilience Fund

Co-Lead: Sierra Institute for Community & Environment

Co-Lead: North State Planning & Development Collective

- Funded by Governor's Office of Planning & Research (OPR)
- Creates 10-county regional collaborative: Butte, Glenn, Lassen, Modoc, Plumas, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Tehama, and Trinity
- 2 to 5-year roadmap with equity, job quality, sustainability, and a transition to carbon-neutral economy focus
- Plan to be completed by end of 2024
