MATERIALS PALETTE

A. Flooring (Living Area) Light oak with defined grain for texture, minimal color variation.

B. Flooring (Bedrooms)

Textured carpet in gray tones

C. Cabinets (Kitchen)

Dark Navy-Black

Alternate: Charcoal Gray

Possibly- mixed materials/use darker stained wood cabinets in select areas

D. Countertop (Kitchen)

Pental Quartz "Pearl White"

E. Finishes (Faucets, Hardware, etc)

Brushed Nickel

F. Flooring (Bath)

Large format cement-look tile in warm gray; very thin grout lines.

Alternate: Slate tile

G. Cabinets/Casework (Bath)


Warm, medium-dark wood

H. Countertop (Bath)

Cambria "Ella Matte" or similar

I. Shower Tile (Bath)

Large format marble or stone look



MATERIALS INSPIRATION KITCHEN AREA

Dark navy cabinets

Honed-finish solid surface
countertop with warmth and
neutral color, not too much pattern

Wood floor continues
from living area

Fixture/hardware finishes tbd
Black stainless steel appliances to
blend into cabinets





Mix in a touch of warm wood in darker finish.

Slab panel cabinet fronts

Solid surface countertop continues up backsplash

Drawers below counter throughout kitchen
Minimal drawer pulls

Charcoal Gray as alternate
Thick slab edge

MATERIALS PALETTE KITCHEN AREA

Warm and light feel.

Grounded by darker slab-front cabinets.

Black stainless appliances to create streamlined look with cabinets.

Solid surface countertop with soft texture and minimal pattern for modern look.

Fixtures and appliances with streamlined silhouettes in brushed nickel or similar tone.

Consider mix of metals and woods (example have upper cabinets be wood vs. paint).
