

**NOTICE OF ELECTION

ARGUMENT – REBUTTAL FILING INFORMATION
MEASURE “D”**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in accordance with the provisions of the California Elections Code, that at the Presidential General Election held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, the Plumas County Board of Supervisors have called for a measure for the purpose of obtaining voter approval, by a two-thirds majority vote of the following measure:

“Shall a measure authorizing the County of Plumas to impose a special transaction and use tax in the total amount of three fourth percent (3/4%) to be used solely for purpose of providing the citizens in Plumas County Public Safety Services through the Plumas County Sheriff’s Office be approved?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the dates for filing arguments for or against the measure is August 8 through August 19, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. Arguments may not exceed 300 words each and must be accompanied by a “Statement of Author Form” available at <https://plumascounty.us/DocumentCenter/View/4053/Statement-of-Author-Form> signed by each author. Rebuttals to arguments in favor or against the measure may not exceed 250 words and can be filed with the County Clerk beginning August 20, 2024 through August 29, 2024 at 5:00 p.m, and must include the “Statement of Author Form” available at <https://plumascounty.us/DocumentCenter/View/4053/Statement-of-Author-Form>.
