

Dixie Fire Recovery For-Profit Business Economic Development GRANT PROGRAM INFORMATION



In response to the economic hardships due to the 2021 Dixie Fire, the County of Plumas has established a business assistance grant program using Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Dixie Fire Recovery For-Profit Business Economic Development Grant Program will provide assistance through grants to businesses **within areas of Greenville, Crescent Mills, Taylorsville, and the Highway 70 Canyon**.

<p>An eligible for-profit businesses is one that has a physical business location (now or in the future) or qualifies as an online only business within the Grant Eligibility Zone (see reverse) and provides neighborhood serving retail or other goods and service-based businesses available to all residents in Plumas County.</p> <p>Business can employ one or more employees (no size limitation) and must have or obtain a full SAM.gov registration.</p>	<p>To help offset business costs, the Dixie Fire Recovery For-Profit Business Economic Development Grant Program will provide financial assistance to established businesses directly or indirectly impacted by the 2021 Dixie Fire, and start-up businesses post-2021 Dixie Fire.</p> <p>Eligible activities include:</p> <p>(1) Purchase of business Equipment and Supplies</p> <p>(2) Operating Capital Expenses (i.e., payroll, insurance, utilities, rent/mortgage)</p>	<p>First-come, first-served grants on a rolling basis until funds are exhausted.</p> <p>Up to \$20,000 per grant.</p> <p>An additional \$2,700 increase in grant funding may be awarded if a business purchases the eligible activities locally in Plumas County.</p> <p>The maximum award amount cannot exceed \$22,700.</p>
