

NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an election will be held on April 14, 2026, within the boundaries of the Whitehawk Ranch Community Services District, to approve a measure for the purpose of obtaining voter approval, by a two-thirds majority vote, of the following measure:

“Upon a two-thirds majority vote of approval by ballots cast by Whitehawk Ranch registered voters - “Shall the “Whitehawk Ranch Community Services District (CSD) adopt a tax increase of \$231.00 per residential parcel and \$462.00 per commercial parcel as well as subsequent 2.5% annual parcel tax increases in order to provide for the ongoing maintenance, repairs, operations and upgrades including but not limited to the CSD’s properties and services including the swimming pool, spa, tennis/pickle ball courts, gazebo, community center, exercise/maintenance building, bocce ball court/horseshoe area, pond, equestrian center, parking area, burn pile, RV storage area and approximately one hundred acres of hiking trails and open space with associated defensible space maintenance?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the dates for filing arguments for or against the measure is December 29, 2025 through January 9, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. Arguments may not exceed 300 words each and must be accompanied by a “Form Statement” available at www.plumascounty.us, signed by each author. Rebuttals to arguments in favor or against the measure may not exceed 250 words and must be filed with the County Clerk by January 20, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. The office of the Plumas County Clerk Elections Division located in the Courthouse at 520 Main Street, Room 102, Quincy will be the processing place for all ballots from March 16, 2026 through April 22, 2026. Equipment testing will be March 12, 2026 and is open to the public. For more information, call (530) 283-6256.
